KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That F&B Mineral Management LLC, a Texas limited liability company whose address is: PO Box 60646, Corpus Christi, Texas 78466, hereinafter called Grantor, (whether one or more) for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00 & OVC) cash in hand paid and other good and valuable considerations, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey, transfer, assign and deliver unto John P. Wandel, Jr. whose address is: PO Box 60646, Corpus Christi, Texas 78466, hereinafter called Grantee, whether one or more, all of Grantor's undivided rights, titles, claims and interests in the Lands described herein, of any and every kind, nature and/or character, in and to all of the oil, gas, coal and other minerals, including without limitation, all of the oil royalty, gas royalty, overriding royalty, royalty in casinghead gas and gasoline in, on and under, that may be produced from the following described lands (the "Lands") situated in Leon County, State of Texas, to-wit:

FIRST TRACT: 782.95 acres of land, more or less, situated in the Pedro Pereire, Jose De Jesus and Mariano Grande XI Leagues Survey, A-17 in Leon County, Texas and being the same land described in five (5) tracts in that certain Mineral Deed dated August 16, 1951 from Darwin S. Fenner to A.C. Beane, Jr., et al, and recorded in Volume 192, Page 253 of the Deed Records of Leon County, Texas.

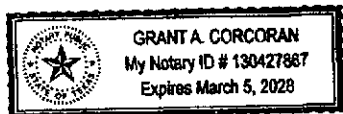
